I am writing to explain why the Second Pre-election Contribution and Expenditure Report for the Religious Response Network was not filed. Let me begin by saying that as the new treasurer of this PAC it has been my intention to comply with the procedures required for accounting the RRN's financial activity during the 2004 elections. Never having accepted such a responsibility each filing was a learning process for me. I made repeated phone calls to Jan who was listed on the front of the Campaign Finance Manual. She was most helpful in answering my question during each filing period. However my work as treasurer during the campaign was interrupted due to a serious family illness.

On October 14, 2004, we received the news that our son's wife was diagnosed with Stage IV metastatic breast cancer. Our son, his wife and 4 month old baby live in Alexandria, VA. On October 15, 2004, we flew to Washington D.C. where she was hospitalized. We returned to Eugene on October 18 until October 30. During this period of time we rearranged our lives so we could return to Alexandria helping our children through this most difficult time. Knowing that our attention was now with our family and not the campaign, I turned over the Religious Response Network checkbook to Irwin Noparstak who deposited and wrote checks for RRN until I was able to resume the treasurer's responsibilities on November 13, 2004 at which time the checkbook was returned to me. I, then, prepared and filed the post election report.

Because my attention was on family during this period of time, October 14 through November 13, and as I was not handling the expenditures for RRN, I unintentionally overlooked the need to file the supplemental report. I did file the Post Election report and received an Exam Letter dated December 17, 2004. This exam letter noted that I had not completed the aggregates on post election report but made no mention of my failure to file the supplemental report to the second pre-election report.

I sincerely request your forgiveness of my failure to file the supplemental report as: 1.) we were and are dealing with a personal emergency of serious family illness, and 2.) that I was not reminded of this omission on the exam letter dated December 17, 2004.

Enclosed please find the following attached:

- a. A notarized statement from Dr. John Leboe, who counseled us on the severity of the diagnosis on October 18 upon our return from our initial trip to Alexandria, VA.
- b. A notarized statement from Irwin Noparstak who is the second signature of the RRN account and was responsible for paying expenses during my absence.
- c. Copies of e-mail correspondence documenting this emergency and my decision to step back from RRN responsibilities from October 14 through November 13, 2004.
- d. To document our trips to D.C. copies of credit card bills noting dates our flights were posted to our account.



Dearest Friends Rob and Alaine, I wish I were writing to ask to see you both under better times. Just last Friday Lizzie (Mike's wife) was diagnosed with breast cancer, stage four. She has tumors in her liver, spine, breast, bone marrow. Is currently in George Washington University Hospital. We came in for last week end, just in time to support them through her first Cheomo. Stayed in a hotel and rented a car. Lizzie's mother and father are staying at their home. We were able to trade off taking care of the baby and spending time with Lizzie.

She may have gone home today. We haven't heard yet. Let's hope! But according to the usual path of chemo therapy the 8th day is usually a day of either getting on top of the cancer or things getting worse. The advice Karen and I are getting is to come back for this time. We can so easily go into deep despair. It is much too difficult being so far away. So we are thinking to return sometime next week. Would it be possible to stay with you? We might either rent a car or we could learn to use the Metro. This has all happened so fast that we need the love and friendship that you two so well give.

Today she went back for blood draws and her platelets and white cells are recovering (not high enough yet, tho). She ate lasagne with us last night and she's really working on eating - including 2-3 Ensure per day.

It appears that this third week since chemo, Lizzie as expected is feeling better. On Friday, her blood counts will be checked again and if the platelets are high enough she'll be given her 2nd round of chemo next Monday. So tomorrow on election day both Lizzie (wearing a mask) and Mike plan to vote and then we'll all stay up late to josh and lament over the election. It is so wonderful to have the feisty Lizzie back!
