

I would like to thank you for the opportunity to testify. I do the C & E for Mr. Curtright. Having had an electronic filing system since the start, I know most of the rules. I do find though, that every now and then one pops up that is new to me.

In reading the rules for filing the September supplemental (page 11 of the 2006 Campaign Finance Manual) it states: "A committee that was active in the primary election and will also be active in the general election does not need to file a September supplemental."

Mr. Curtright had every intention on being active in the election. Although not as a candidate, he was still looking forward to being an active participant until November 7th. I had filed the rest of my clients who were required to file the SUPP on time....had I had any idea that Mr. Curtright had to file a supplemental, it would have been done. I had his General 1st PRE ready to be filed.

As of this date, his Supp was filed as soon as I was notified, his amendment filed on time and the discontinuation of his committee will be filed tomorrow, October 11, 2006.

I ask that since this was an error on my part and his committee discontinued, that there be no fine imposed on him.
