

- 2. Time/Date stamped computer copy of electronic filing sent with attachments on Tuesday September 26, 2006. (Also included time/date stamped e-mails of three others sent at the same time.) E-mail response from staff for first client filing on September 26, 2006 very odd.**
- 3. Time/Date stamped computer copy of another client filing sent September 28, 2006. Response from server – delayed and not received until September 30, 2006. Hard copy faxed to office on October 1, 2006.**
- 4. Time/Date stamped computer copy of 004016 filed again on October 1, 2006 with hard copy, including printout of electronic filing e-mailed on October 1, 2006.**
- 5. All clients filed and/or refilled (if needed) on October 1, 2006, with hard copies faxed.**

Your system had a failure on Friday September 30, 2006, but the failure actually started on Tuesday, September 26 with the e-mail system.

I must compliment your staff on their handling of the outage. Their notification, calling attention to the problem on Friday was appreciated, as well as their handling of the problem with 004016 on Tuesday....they are always gracious. I was informed on Tuesday, October 3, 2006 that they had received the faxed hard copy, but not the electronic filing. I immediately forwarded to the office, the September 26, 2006 electronic filing I had sent on Sunday. I was told by staff that even though the original e-mail with attached file was

dated Sunday, October 1, 2006, it wasn't posted until Tuesday, which made it a day late.

I ask that no fine be imposed on this committee. As seen by the attachments, their electronic filing was sent in as required and on time.

Dear Mr. Scholz:

The purpose of this letter is to notify you of the potential for a civil penalty due to the late filing of your first pre-election contribution and expenditure report for the November 7, 2006, General Election. The deadline for filing was 5:00 pm, October 2, 2006, in the office of the Secretary of State, Elections Division. Your immediate attention to this matter is critical as the penalty increases every day your report is late.

A committee that is not required to file electronically can send the report by mail (Elections Division, 141 State Capitol, Salem, Oregon 97310-0722) or fax (503-373-7414).

A committee that is required to file electronically should email the report in the appropriate electronic format to elecfile.sos@state.or.us. A report that is required to be filed electronically is late until it is successfully filed electronically. If a paper copy of the report is provided to the Secretary of State, Elections Division, prior to the electronic filing, the penalty is reduced by 75 percent, beginning with the day a paper copy of the report is submitted.

Once the Secretary of State, Elections Division, receives your report, a "Notice of Proposed Civil Penalty" will be sent to the treasurer of the committee. The penalty for filing a late report is a percentage of the total contributions or total expenditures—whichever is greater—for each business day the report is late.

This notification is being sent pursuant to ORS 260.205. A civil penalty may be imposed by the Secretary of State in accordance with ORS 260.232 and OAR 165-012-0005.

If your committee is not soliciting or expending funds to support or oppose candidates, measures or a political party at the November 7, 2006, General Election, you are not required to file contribution and expenditure reports for the election. However, you do need to notify us in writing immediately that the committee will be inactive for the election.

Dear Mr. Scholz:

This letter constitutes a Notice of Proposed Civil Penalty. Please read the information below carefully and contact our office if you have any questions about its contents or necessary actions on your part.

Reason for Notice:

This notice is being sent to you as a result of the late filing of your first pre-election contribution and expenditure report (see ORS 260.073 and ORS 260.159). This report was required to be filed electronically and was due in the office of the Secretary of State, Elections Division, not later than 5:00 pm, October 2, 2006. Your electronic report was filed on October 3, 2006, making it one business day late. A paper copy of the report was provided to the filing officer on October 2, 2006.

Authority for Civil Penalty:

The Secretary of State has the authority to impose civil penalties in accordance with ORS 260.232 and has adopted the 2006 *Campaign Finance Manual* by administrative rule. The penalty is imposed against the treasurer of record at the time of the violation.

Explanation of the Penalty Matrix:

Enclosed is the penalty matrix used in calculating penalties for late reports. This matrix reduces the maximum statutory civil penalty to an amount not to exceed a percentage of the total contributions or total expenditures — whichever is greater — for each business day the report was late. The percentage is based upon whether the treasurer has committed any previous late violations since September 15, 2005, as follows:

- First Violation: One percent
- Second Violation: Three percent
- Third or Subsequent Violation: Five percent

The matrix sets minimum penalties based on the number of previous late violations and maximum penalties based on the type of report and the activity level of the committee during the accounting period of the late report.

Additionally, if a paper copy of a report that is required to be filed electronically is provided to the filing officer prior to the electronic copy, the penalty as calculated above for a late report is reduced by 75% (making the penalty one-quarter of 1, 3 or 5% per day), beginning with the day a paper copy of the report is submitted.

Proposed Civil Penalty:

The Secretary is proposing a civil penalty of \$29.41 ($\$11,764.08 \times 1\% \times 1 \text{ day} \times 25\%$). This calculated penalty takes into consideration that \$11,764.08 is the greater of the total contributions or total expenditures during the accounting period for the late report, a paper copy of the report was provided one day prior to the electronic copy, and this is the treasurer's first late violation.

Reduction or Waiver of Penalty:

A reduction or waiver of the penalty will be considered only if one of the following mitigating circumstances is present:

- a) the lateness is the direct result of clearly-established fraud, embezzlement or other criminal activity against the committee, committee treasurer or candidate, as determined in a criminal or civil action in a court of law or independently corroborated by a report of a law enforcement agency or insurer or the sworn testimony or affidavit of an accountant or bookkeeper or the person who actually engaged in the criminal activity;
- b) the lateness is the direct result of fire, flood, utility failure or other calamitous event, resulting in physical destruction of, or inaccessibility to, committee records;
Calamitous event means a phenomenon of an exceptional character, the effects of which could not have been reasonably prevented or avoided by the exercise of due care or foresight.
- c) the lateness is the direct result of failure of a professional delivery service to deliver documents in the time guaranteed for delivery by written receipt of the service provider (this does not include delivery by fax);
- d) the lateness is the direct result of an error by the elections filing officer; or
- e) the lateness is the direct result of a valid personal emergency of the candidate or treasurer. In this case, independent written verification must be provided.
A valid personal emergency is a serious personal illness or death in the immediate family of the candidate or treasurer, which caused a report to be late. Personal emergency does not include a common cold or flu, or a long-term illness where other arrangements could have been made.

It is your responsibility to show that one of the listed circumstances occurred and that it caused the late filing of your report.

Opportunity to Request a Hearing:

You have 20 days* from the date you received this certified letter to take one of the following actions:

Action	Result
Request a hearing to be conducted by an independent hearings officer to present evidence of mitigating circumstances (public hearing). This hearing will be held by telephone unless you request that it be a personal appearance hearing held in Salem.	A public hearing will be scheduled within 30 days and you will be notified of the date and time. You may choose to submit written notarized testimony or other evidence in lieu of a public hearing. <i>Those documents must be received not later than three business days before the day of the hearing.</i>
Submit a notarized written explanation providing evidence of mitigating circumstances (letter hearing).	No public hearing will be scheduled and an order will be issued based on the written testimony and the hearing record (which is the agency file for this committee).
Do not take any action.	A penalty will be assessed based on available information.

(* If the certified letter is refused or left unclaimed at the post office, the 20-day period begins on the day the post office indicates it has given first notice of a certified letter.)
